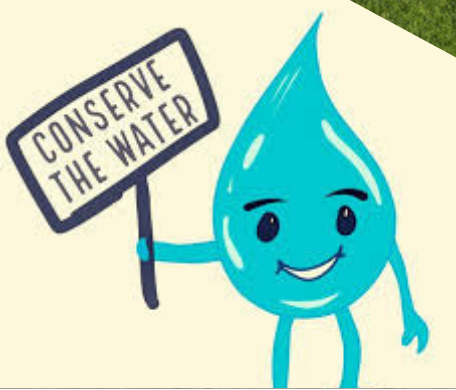
SNAKE AND LADDER GAME

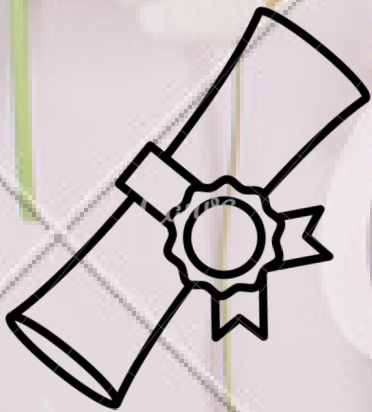

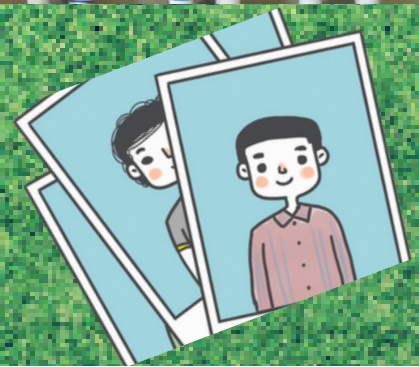
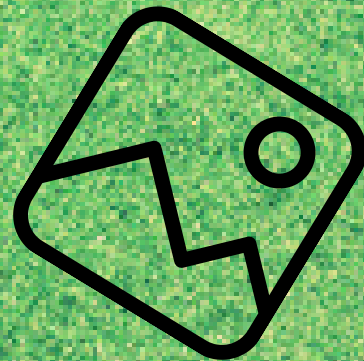
FAMILY PHOTO FRAME ACTIVITY

RED DAY

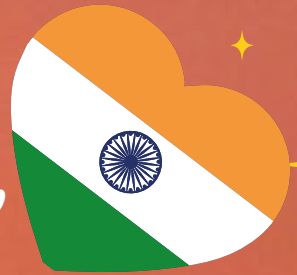

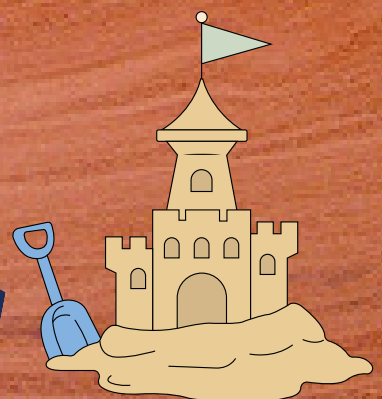
